OUR GUIDE TO HAPPY, HEALTHY DANCING

River Oaks Dance intends to comply with, at a minimum, the guidelines set forth by the Texas Department of Health and Human Services to keep our dancers and staff healthy. We take pride in our program and how it operates. This is where we are right now, but things may change as the situation changes. Your child's health, safety and wellbeing is our highest priority. We will keep you updated on what is happening through email.

Studio

Upon arrival at the studio

Our studio is located at 3641 Westheimer Road, Suite C. Please park at the back of the building closest to the Briar Club parking garage and walk your child to the door.



Only dancers will be allowed to enter the studio

Parents will wait outside while their child is in class. One parent/caregiver will accompany the children in the Mommy & Me class. If your child needs to change into dance clothes, a parent may come in to the changing area to help their child or their carpool group to change.



Temperature check

Temperature will be taken of students and teachers before each class and must be below 100.4 to participate in class.



WHAT PRECAUTIONS ARE WE TAKING?

Sanitize hands before and after class

We will ask all students to wash their hands before class. We will also provide sanitizer for the children to sanitize their hands during class as needed and upon exiting class.




Students are required to wear masks in class.

Students over three years old are required to wear masks. We feel this is the best way ensure everyone's safety. We understand they are young and it may be hard for the little ones to wear a mask, but we will work with them and take "mask breaks" as needed. Teachers and parents are required to wear a face mask at all times in the studio.

Stay in your individual dance zone

We will make every effort to keep the children at least six feet from one another in our dance space and will have a specific physically distanced spot for each child to participate in class. We use lots of props in our younger classes and I will have a personal prop package for each child to take back and forth to dance class. Prop Packages are \$25 and will be charged to your account.



Sanitizing procedure

Studio surfaces will be sanitized between class in addition to the continuous daily cleaning.

In case of a teacher or student testing positive for COVID

If a teacher or student tests positive for COVID, the class will be notified and the individual may return to class when all four of the following criteria are met: 1. at least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications); and 2. the individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and 3. at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared; and 4. a negative COVID test result is received.
